## 2024.1/A BAA Schedule

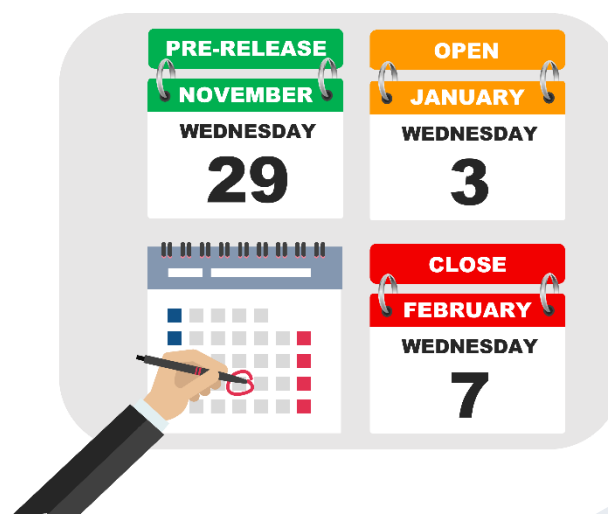
DON SBIR 24.1 and STTR 24.A topics will be pre-released on November 29, 2023. The pre-release period allows direct public communication between small businesses and topic technical points of contact (TPOCs) to answer technical questions about the topics. The DoD and DON SBIR 24.1 and STTR 24.A BAAs will officially open for proposal submissions on January 3, 2024, and close on February 7 at 12:00 PM ET.
